DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,778**, dated August 13, 1878; application filed July 24, 1878.
[Term of patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HUGH CHRISTIE, of Morrisania, New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Carpet, of which the following is a specification:

The accompanying drawing illustrates a face view of my new design for a carpet.

This invention relates to a new design for a carpet, oil-cloth, or similar fabric; and consists in the new arrangement and ornamentation of figures hereinafter described.

The letter A represents my newly-designed carpet. *a* is a castle represented on the same, and partly hidden by a group of flowers and leaves, *b*. At the side of the castle *a* is a lattice fence, *c*, represented partially in a perspective view, and appearing to partly inclose

a square field, as shown. The carpet is also ornamented by straight crossing bars *d* and the additional groups of flowers and leaves *e*.

I claim—

1. The design for a carpet having the castle *a* and group *b*, substantially as shown.
2. The design for a carpet having the fence *c*, substantially as shown.
3. The design for a carpet having the straight crossing bars *d* and groups *e*, substantially as shown.
4. The design for a carpet having the castle *a*, group *b*, fence *c*, bars *d*, and group *e*, substantially as shown.
